

Privacy Policy

In compliance with Article 13 of EU Regulation 679/2016 and Legislative Decree 196/2003 and Legislative Decree 101/2018 following the entry into force, this privacy policy is intended to describe the methods adopted for the processing of users' personal data to allow online registration and/or access to institutional and/or conference events organized and managed by the CNIT (Interuniversity Consortium for Telecommunications).

Purpose of processing:

Your personal data which have been freely given to us and which we have acquired accordingly of the activity carried out by CNIT, will be treated lawfully and correctly for the following purpose: collection of registrations and/or registrations to allow CNIT to implement all steps necessary to formalize participation in the event organized by the CNIT itself. For statistical and informative purposes, CNIT may request explicit consent to images, photographs and video shoots. Optionally, you can authorize the CNIT to communicate your contact details (name, surname, e-mail) to event partners for direct marketing purposes.

Types of data processed:

When registering online, the user is asked to enter some personal data (personal data and contact details). The personal data provided by users during online registration are used by CNIT only for the purpose of providing the requested service. In case the user does not provide such data or your consent to their processing, CNIT will not be able to guarantee the requested service. For statistical purposes, it may be appropriate for the student to also specify particular data ex sensitive for which we will explicitly ask for consent (e.g. age, qualification, field of study, specific skills, programming languages, skills).

Treatment methods:

The data will be processed in such a way as to guarantee adequate security and confidentiality by adopting the following procedures: collection of data from the interested party, registration for specific purposes and legitimate, processing in terms consistent with these purposes and carried out by electronic means and automated (data collection via the Internet, through online registration on the event website, directly to the interested party). Specific security measures are adopted to prevent data loss and illicit or otherwise correct and unauthorized access. The data processed will be constantly updated and complete and, to this end, we invite users to send notifications in order to make updates and corrections where necessary. The processing of personal data is limited to employees and contract workers who need this information to carry out their business, as well as to manage, develop and improve the service.

Legal basis of processing:

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data relies on your choice of registration for the course, necessary to participate. Mandatory or optional nature of the data and consequences in case of refusal and an answer: The nature of the provision of your personal data is mandatory so that the Data Controller can proceed to process your request to participate in the course. In case of refusal, it will not be possible to complete the registration procedure and the Owner will not be able to carry out the activity.

Communication of data to third parties:

Your personal data will be processed by the Data Controller, by Data Processors appointed by the Owner and by strictly authorized data processors. The data can be communicated to the course-promoting partners in order to fulfil all obligations. Your contact details (name, surname, e-mail) may be provided to the course partners for direct marketing purposes if you provide explicit consent in this regard. Following inspections or

checks, your personal data may be communicated to all bodies and inspectors responsible for inspections and checks relating to the legitimacy of legal obligations.

Data retention periods:

Your personal data will be kept for the time strictly necessary for the organization and event management. CNIT will retain essential data (invoicing etc.) for the time required by the current legislation.

Transfer of data to third countries or international organizations:

The Data Controller does not intend to transfer the data collected to third countries or international organizations.

Data controller:

The Data Controller is CNIT (Consorzio Nazionale Interuniversitario per le Telecomunicazioni), with Registered Office in Viale G.P. Usberti, 181 / A Pal.3 - 43124 Parma (PR), in the person of its pro-tempore Legal Representative.

The processing connected to the collection of data is carried out at the CNIT headquarters and is carried out by the consortium staff in charge of processing, as well as by any persons in charge of occasional maintenance operations of CNIT servers.

Rights of interested parties:

The interested party has the right at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data concerning him, even if not yet registered, and their communication in a form intelligible. The interested party has the right to obtain the indication of the origin of the personal data; from the purposes and methods of processing; of the logic applied in case of processing carried out with the use of electronic instruments; of the identification details of the Owner, of the Manager of processing and of the representative designated according to Article 5 and Article 15 of EU Regulation 679/2016 and Legislative Decree 196/2003, Legislative Decree 101/2018; the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of such data. The interested party has the right to obtain the update, rectification or if desired, data integration; the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of such data when data is processed in violation of the law; to a statement confirming that I passage specified here, and the content of such passages, were brought to the attention of the subjects to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated unless this proves impossible or requires use of means which is manifestly disproportionate to the right to be protected. The interested party has the right to object - in whole or in part - for legitimate reasons to the processing of personal data that concern, even where the processing is relevant to the purposes for which they were collected; to the processing of personal data concerning him for the purpose of sending advertising material or for the carrying out market research or for commercial communication purposes. In particular, the interested party has the right to ask the Data Controller for access to the data at any time personal data and the rectification, cancellation or limitation of the processing of data concerning him or to oppose their processing, in addition to the right to data portability. The interested party also has the right to withdraw your consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of processing based on consent given before revocation. The interested party has the right to propose a complaint to the Supervisory Authority. Rights can be exercised by sending a communication to the email address [dpo\[at\]cnit.it](mailto:dpo[at]cnit.it), specifying name, surname and order number received via email at the time of registration.
